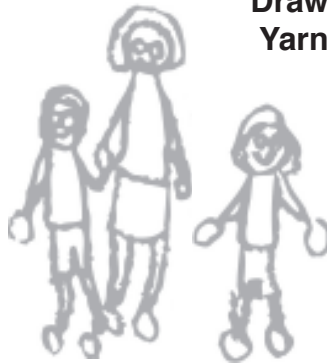

Girl Scout Visit Policies and Procedures

- Workshop cost is \$7.00 per girl scout and includes admission to the Museum, materials, a Museum educator to lead activities, and a certificate of completion. (Actual badges not included.)
- Reservations are required; call for availability. (Leaders - you are welcome to bring a snack for your group!) Workshops must be scheduled at least two weeks in advance.
- Workshops last about two hours and allow for time to explore the Museum.
- A minimum of 8 girls per group is required, maximum of 16 girls.
- Chaperones are free of charge; one chaperone is required for every five scouts.
- Tag-a-longs can participate at \$7 each, or explore the Museum at \$3 each.
