Sick Child Policy

The Central Wisconsin Children's Museum works to provide a safe and healthy environment for all our visitors. With that in mind, we request the following Sick Child Policy be followed by our visitors and our staff.

A general rule to follow is that if the child (or adult) has any temperature or is too sick to go to school, they are too sick to visit the museum.

The following guidelines are more specific and we request that children with these symptoms not visit the museum. Staff may be called upon to identify the following symptoms and to ask a visitor to leave. If a visitor is asked to leave, free passes to return will be given to the visitor.

1. Eye infection (conjunctivitis) or "pink eye".
2. Diarrhea
3. Cold - a fresh sneezy and runny cold, whooping cough
4. Impetigo - infectious skin disease which shows up as small pimples that turn into red blisters in a circular pattern.
5. Vomiting
6. Lice
7. Strep Throat - the child must be on antibiotics for 24 hours before coming to the museum.
8. Any of the following childhood contagious diseases: measles, mumps, rubella, rosella, and chicken pox. Children with chicken pox may not come until all of the sores are crusted and there are no new eruptions.
