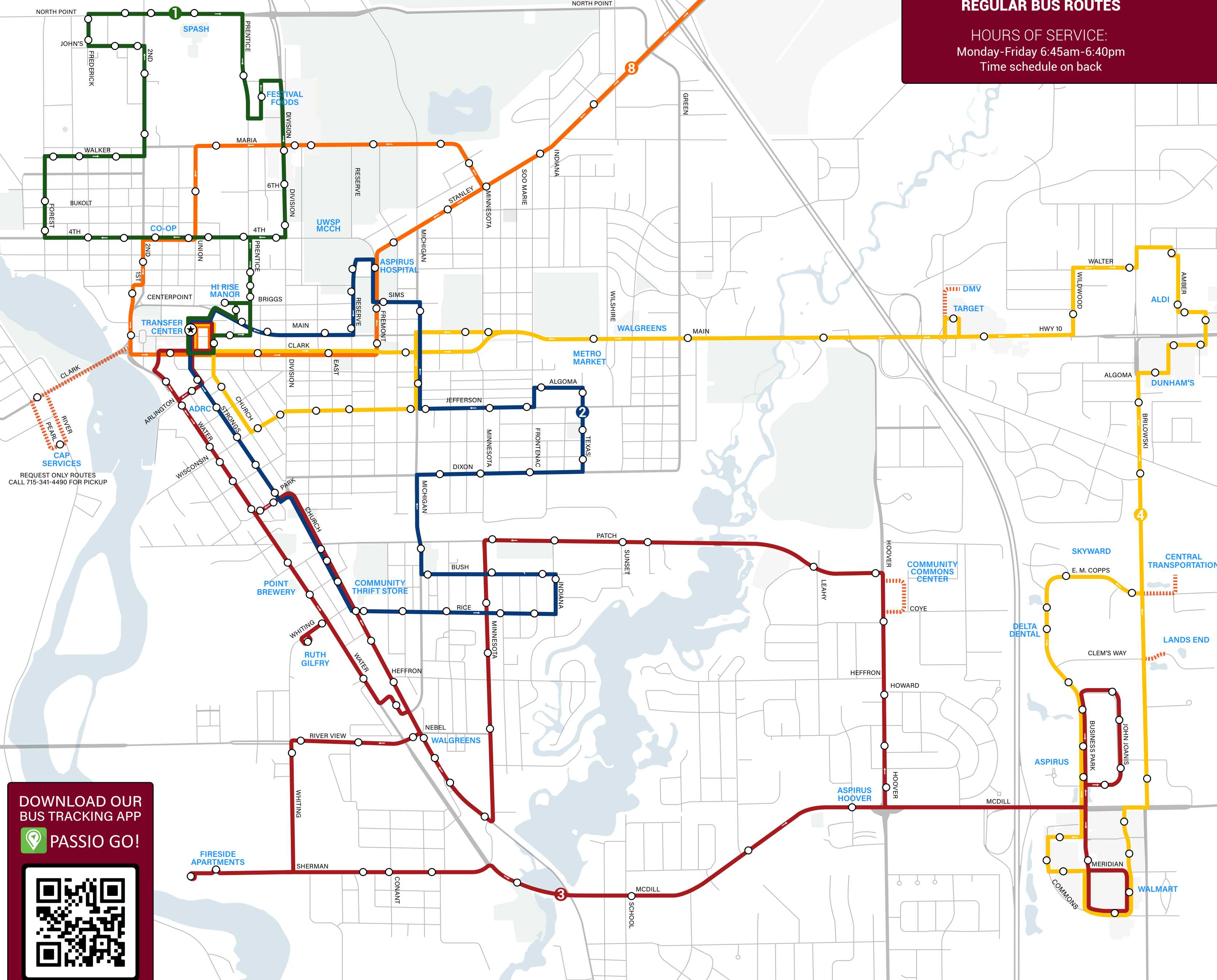

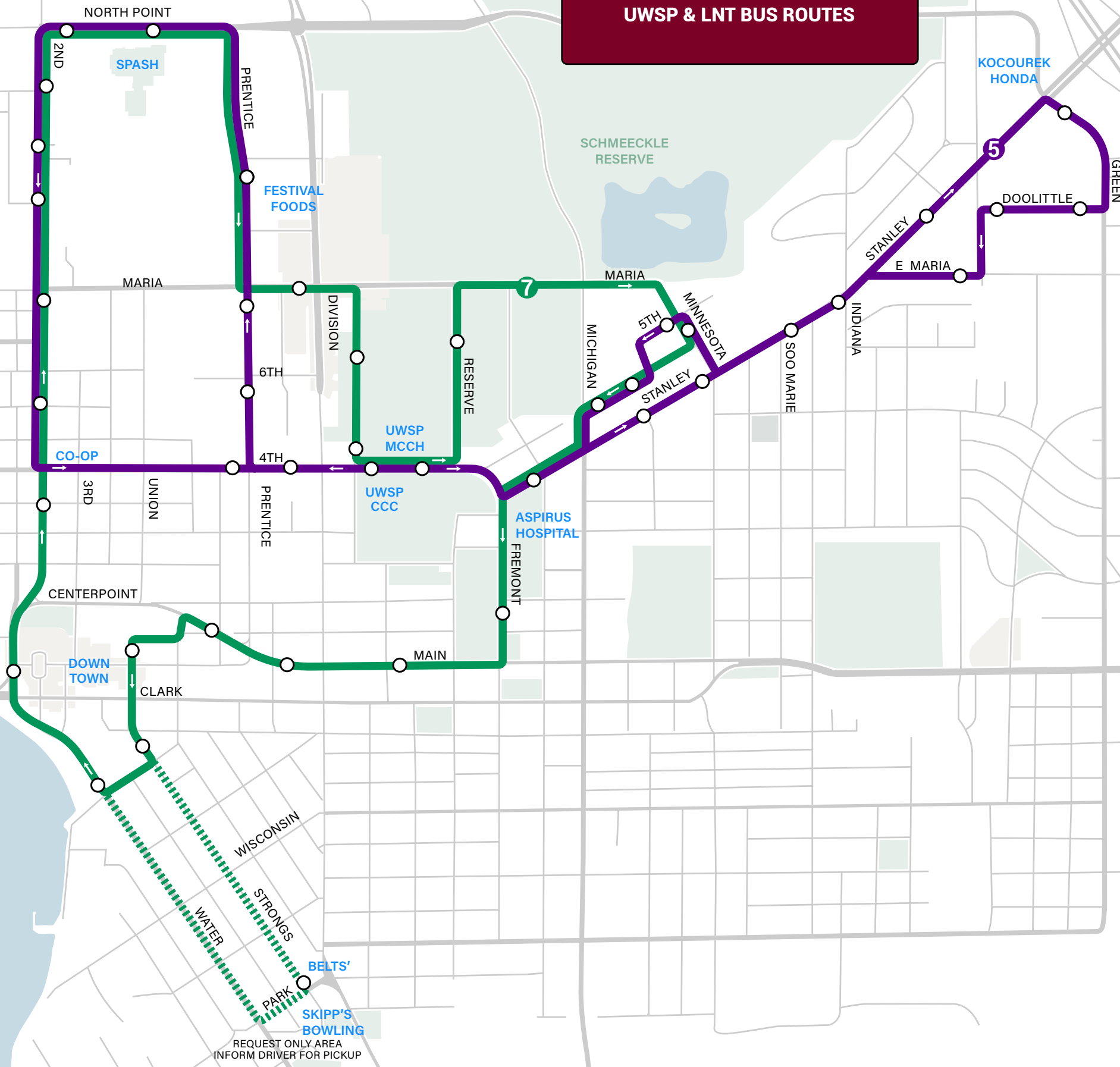

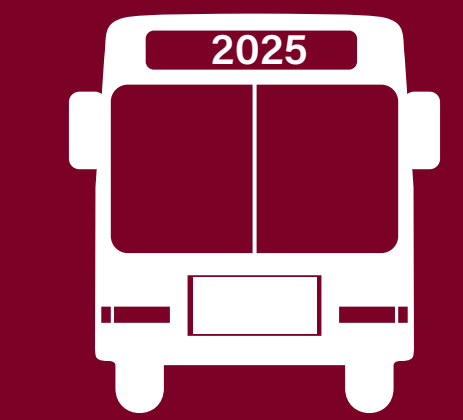

Transfers
If you need to use more than one bus to reach your destination (one way), ask your driver for a transfer. Transfers are free when fare is paid on the first bus. Please tell the driver what bus you are transferring to so the driver can ensure your connection.

Travel Training
One-on-one training designed to help individuals learn to travel safely and independently on public transportation. Travel training is provided free of charge except for your bus fare.

Accessibility
All buses are equipped with a mobility device ramp. If you are unable to climb the step the bus can be lowered.

Priority Seats
Seats directly behind driver and those in the front of the bus are reserved for seniors and people with disabilities. You may be asked to move from these seats if requested by priority passengers.

Safety
Keep aisles clear of items, strollers, etc.

- No weapons
- No eating, drinking, smoking, or vaping
- No use of loud or offensive language
- No animals except for service animals
- Use headphones to listen to music
- Must wear shoes and shirt
- Never cross the street in front of the bus
- Bike racks are on the front of the bus
- Bikes are not allowed inside the bus
- Signal the driver about a block prior to your stop by pulling the cord
